AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MCLLOUD, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING TITLE 1, SECTION 1, OF THE MCLLOUD CITY CODE TO ADD A NEW SECTION 1-1-6 TO PROVIDE FOR WARD BOUNDARIES; DECLARING REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCLLOUD, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The McLoud Code of Ordinances is amended to add a new Section 1-1-6 to read as follows: The ward boundaries of the City of McLoud shall be as follows:

WARD #1

Beginning at the point where SH 102 crosses the North Canadian River following the easterly course of the river to Blackberry Drive; thence south on Blackberry Drive to North Deer Creek boundary; thence west along the creek to South Arena Road; north on South Arena Road to West Oklahoma Street; thence easterly on West Oklahoma/Broadway to North 8<sup>th</sup> Street; thence north on North 8<sup>th</sup> Street to West Hinchley Avenue; thence east on Hinchley Avenue to a point where North 3<sup>rd</sup> meets the railroad tracks; thence northwesterly following the tracks to SH 102; thence north on SH 102 to the North Canadian River.

WARD #2

Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of North Arena Road & West Oklahoma east to South 8<sup>th</sup> Street; thence south to Redskin Road; thence east on Redskin Road to McLoud Road; thence south on McLoud Road to North Deer Creek boundary; thence west along the creek to South Arena Road; thence north on South Arena to West Oklahoma.

WARD #3

Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of North Fishmarket and Kickapoo Roads continuing east to south bank of the North Canadian River; thence easterly to SH 102; thence south to the railroad crossing; thence southeast on railroad track to North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street/Hinchley Avenue intersection; thence west on Hinchley to North 8<sup>th</sup> Street; thence south to West Broadway; thence west to West Oklahoma Street and continuing west on West Oklahoma Street to South Arena Road; thence south to North Deer Creek boundary; thence west along the creek to Pottowatomie Road; thence north to Redskin Road; thence east to North Fishmarket Road; thence north 1 1/2 mile; thence west 1/2 mile; thence north 1/2 mile to Kickapoo Road; thence east 1/4 mile; thence south 1980 feet; thence east 1/4 mile to North Fishmarket Road (this portion consists of the McLoud Cemetery and Mabel Bassett Prison); thence north 1980 feet to Kickapoo Road.

WARD #4

Beginning at a point 1/2 mile south of Murry Drive on Pottowatomie Road continuing south to Parkwood; thence east 1 mile to Fishmarket; thence south on Fishmarket 3/4 mile;

thence west ¼ mile; thence south ½ mile; thence east ¼ mile; thence north ¼ mile; thence east along Interstate 40 ½ mile; thence south ½ mile to Memorial Road; thence west ½ mile on Memorial Road; thence north 200 feet; thence west 1 mile to Pottowatomie Road; thence south on Pottowatomie Road 400 feet (200 feet south of Memorial Road); thence east (parallel 200 feet south of Memorial Road) 4 ¾ miles; thence south ¼ mile; thence east ¾ mile; thence north 1 mile; thence west ½ mile to SH 102; thence west on Westech Road 1 mile; thence north ¼ mile to the North Deer Creek boundary; thence 4 miles in a northwesterly direction to Pottowatomie Road (½ mile south of Murry Drive).

SECTION 2: REPEALER

All former ordinances or parts of ordinances conditioning or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: EMERGENCY

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of McLoud and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.

PASSED AND APPROVED, and the Emergency Clause voted upon separately and passed and approved, this 14<sup>th</sup> day of DECEMBER 2006.




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
