

ORDINANCE NO. 442

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING AND CHANGING THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MEDFORD, GRANT COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING REAL ESTATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

A tract or parcel of land lying in the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty-seven (27) North, Range Five (5) West in Grant County, Oklahoma more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 15, thence North along the West section line a distance of 644.00 feet to the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81;

Thence in a Northeasterly direction along the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81 a distance of 600.00 feet to the Point of Beginning;

Thence in a Southeasterly direction at a 90° angle to the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81 a distance of 300.00 feet;

Thence in a Northeasterly direction parallel to the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81 a distance of 562.00 feet;

Thence in a Northwesterly direction at a 90° angle to the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81 a distance of 300.00 feet to a point on the East Right-of-way line on U.S. Highway No. 81;

Thence in a Southwesterly direction along the East Right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 81 a distance of 562.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, said tract containing 3.88 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the owners of said real estate desire and have consented that the same be made a part of the City of Medford, Grant County, Oklahoma by changing and extending the boundaries of said City to include the real estate described above pursuant to Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 21-103A; and

WHEREAS, it is for the best interests of the City of Medford, Grant County, Oklahoma, and all of its citizens that the above described real estate be annexed and made a part of the corporate limits of the City of Medford, Grant County, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Medford, Grant County, Oklahoma, as follows:

SECTION 1. All of the real estate described above, be and the same hereby is made a part of the corporate limits of the City of Medford, Grant County, Oklahoma

and the former boundaries of said City are hereby changed, extended and altered to include the real estate described above and to include the same within the corporate limits of said City.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Councilmembers are hereby authorized by this Ordinance to note their acceptance and approval upon this original copy as are required by law and such instrument which is to be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Grant County, Oklahoma, in order that the Ordinance may be carried into effect.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, that this Ordinance become effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
