ORDINANCE NO 1424

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA: ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami, Oklahoma;

Section 1

That Chapter 1 Section 4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miami be amended to annex and zone as RM1 (Multiple family residence district- 1,250 square foot minimum lot area per dwelling unit) the following described real property:

SW ¼ of NW ¼ of S17, T28N, R23E, Ottawa Co, Oklahoma

Beginning at the Southwest (SW) corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4) of Section 17, Township 28 North (T28N), Range 23 East (R23E), in Ottawa County, Oklahoma; thence North 360 feet along the West line of said Section 17; thence East 360 feet parallel to the South line of said Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4); thence South 360 feet to the South line of said Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4); thence West 360 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.98 acres more or less

Section 2. – Severability

If any provision, paragraph, word, section or article of this Ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. – Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect the 18th day of June, 2001.

Section 4. – Citation

This Ordinance shall be cited as Chapter 1, Sections 1-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miami, Oklahoma.

Section 5. – Emergency

For the protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby this Ordinance will take effect and be in full force and effect immediately after its passage, approval and publication.


