

ORDINANCE NO. 1559

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA, CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AS FOLLOWS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following real property shall hereby be annexed into the city limits of Miami, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 23 East of the Indian Meridian, Ottawa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, said point being the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 4 of the Replat of Sarasota Addition, run North 00° 16' 50" East 240.00 feet; thence South 89° 44' 59" East 659.89 feet; thence South 00° 16' 50" West 180.00 feet; thence North 89° 44' 59" West 135.00 feet; thence South 00° 16' 50" West 60.00 feet; thence along the North line of said replat North 89° 44' 59" West 524.89 feet to the point of beginning.

This real property is to have a RS-8 zoning designation.


Section 2-Severability. If any provision, paragraph, word, section or article of this Ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3-Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect the 3rd day of May, 2010.


Section 4-Citation. This Ordinance shall be cited as Chapter 1, Section 4, of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Miami, Oklahoma.

Section 5-Emergency. For the protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby this Ordinance will take effect and be in full force and effect immediately after its passage, approval, and publication.
