

ORDINANCE NO. 1560

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA, CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF MIAMI, OKLAHOMA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami, Oklahoma;

Section 1

The following real property shall hereby be annexed into the city limits of Miami, Oklahoma:

See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

This property shall be designated with an RS-8 zoning classification.

Section 2. -- Severability



Section 3 - Emergency Clause

An emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason of which this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately after its passage, approval and publication.


PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled on separately, this June 7th, 2010.







EXHIBIT A

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 28 North, Range 23 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Ottawa County, Oklahoma, Being More Particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at the NW corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence S $89^{\circ}57'00''$ E 990.00 feet along the North line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence S $00^{\circ}22'36''$ E 990.00 feet; thence N $89^{\circ}57'00''$ W 990.00 feet to a point on the West line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence N $00^{\circ}22'36''$ W 990.00 feet along said West line to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Containing 22.50 acres, more or less, Subject to an existing road along the West line and any and all easements of record.
