1917 **ORDINANCE NO. 584(07)**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA, PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF THE TERRITORY INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE ZONING OF PROPERTIES IN THE ANNEXED TERRITORY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY DATE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA;

- § 1. That the corporate limits of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, shall be and the same are hereby extended to include the following described property, to wit: Exhibit "A": attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- § 2. The City Council finds that the above-described area or territory is adjacent to and contiguous to the present corporate limits of said City and that the annexation of said area or territory is authorized by the statues of the State of Oklahoma and in particular by 11 O.S § 21-101, *et seq.*
- § 3. Zoning. That the property located within the annexed territory shall be zoned in accordance with Rezoning Application No. RZ-809 and Ordinance No.580(07), and the platted Estates of Belmar shall be zoned R-1 Single Family Residential in accordance with the existing use; and the following tract of land shall be zoned A-1 Rural Agricultural District:
- A part of the SE/4 of Section 32, T10N, R2W, Cleveland County, Oklahoma beginning at the NE Corner of the SE/4, thence south 200', west 440', thence north 200', thence east 440', to the point of beginning, less and except the SH77 Right-of-Way, also known as Sooner Road.
- § 4. Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

§ 5. Severability. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
