

Ordinance No. 00-3



AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE TOWN OF MORRISON, OKLAHOMA, A TRACT OF LAND FROM THE WEST EDGE OF THE EXISTING CORPORATE LIMITS AND ADJOINING U.S. HIGHWAY 64 THE HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND A TEN FOOT STRIP NORTH A DISTANCE WEST ABOUT TWO AND THREE-EIGHTS MILES AND TO INCLUDE THE PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FIRST BAPTIST OF MORRISON AND A CONNECTION STRIP SOUTH CROSSING U.S. HIGHWAY 64 AND INCLUDING THE PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS BILLS' CORNER (LOTS C1, C2, C3, AND C4 OF LEPLACE SUBDIVISION, NOBLE COUNTY); AND A CONNECTION STRIP CROSSING U.S. HIGHWAY 64 AND INCLUDING THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 2 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, NOBLE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA South of the U.S. Highway 64 RIGHT-OF-WAY (COMMONLY KNOWN AS ROLLING HILLS, MORRISON, OKLAHOMA), MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Morrison, Oklahoma directed at the October 16, 2000 meeting that a notice of this proposed annexation of the herein described territory be published as provided by law;

WHEREAS, the notice of proposed annexation was published and mailed by first-class mail to all owners of property to be annexed as provided by law;

WHEREAS, a plan to extend appropriate town services to the herein described territory has been developed and made available to the public as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MORRISON, OKLAHOMA THAT:

Section 1. That from and after the passage of this Ordinance that the tract of land as shown on the attached map and described as follows:

A strip of land 10 feet wide and lying adjacent to and parallel to the North edge of the U.S. Highway No. 64 right-of-way and beginning at the east edge to the existing cooperate limits of the Town of Morrison,

Oklahoma (the center line of Sec. 18, T21N, R3E of the I.M.) and running Southwesterly to the boundary for the property commonly known as the First Baptist Church of Morrison and including this area lying north of the U.S. Highway No. 64 right-of-way, said First Baptist Church property described as follows:

A piece, parcel and tract of land situated in the West Half (W/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Twenty-one North (21N), Range Three East (3E) of the Indian Meridian, in Noble County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the South boundary line of said Section Eighteen (18), situated 1,611.29 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section Eighteen (18); thence North $00^{\circ} 06' 43''$ East a distance of 471.60 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 53' 17''$ West, at a right angle, a distance of 200 feet; thence South $00^{\circ} 06' 43''$ West to a point situated on the South boundary line of said Section Eighteen (18); thence East, along the South boundary line of said Section Eighteen (18), to the point of beginning;

Said 10 foot wide strip of land continuing west along the North edge of the right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 64 to the west edge of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, T21N, R3E, I.M.; thence continuing west along the North edge of the right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 64 through the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 13, T21N, R2E, I.M. and into the South $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14, T21N, R2E, I.M. for a distance of 1,990 feet west past the center line of said Sec. 14; and to included two 10 foot wide strips of land running north and south and crossing the right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 64 from north to south and located and connecting and including the following properties to this annexation:

1. A 10 foot wide connector of land as described above with the east edge along the west boundary of Section 18 of T21N, R3E, I.M. and connecting all of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24, T21N, R2E, I.M. South of the U.S. Highway No. 64 right-of-way (property commonly known as Rolling Hills, Morrison, Oklahoma) to this annexation; and
2. A 10 foot wide connector of land as described above with the east edge being located 1,980 feet west of the center line of Sections 14 and 23 both of T21N, R2E, I.M. and connecting the property commonly known as Bills' Corner (lots C1, C2, C3, and C4 of LePlace Subdivision, Noble County) to this annexation.

Is hereby annexed to the Town of Morrison, Oklahoma, and that from and after the passage of this Ordinance and the publication thereof, and the compliance with all the laws and regulations pertaining to annexation to a statutory town, such shall constitute a part of the official Town limits of the Town of Morrison, Oklahoma, extending to said property all the rights, benefits, and privileges of all the inhabitants of said Town of Morrison, Oklahoma; and upon the filing of a certified copy of this Ordinance in the office of the County Clerk of Noble County, Oklahoma, such shall be and shall constitute a part of the Town of Morrison, Oklahoma, and the limits are extended to include said property so described.

Section 2. Whereas, it appears for the best interest and for the peace, welfare, and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Morrison, Oklahoma, that the provisions of this Ordinance be put in full force and effect; an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately thereafter its' passage, approval and publication as provided by law.





