AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY ADJACENT TO THE CITY LIMITS UPON CONSENT OF THE OWNER, SAID TERRITORY BEING GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS A TRACT OF LAND IN THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 2, T14N, R18E, AND THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 3, T14N, R18E, MUSKOGEE COUNTY OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (City of Muskogee, Petitioners)

WHEREAS, the owner of at least a majority of the acres described in Section 1 of this ordinance, said land being contiguous to and adjacent to the City of Muskogee, has consented that the same be annexed to and added to the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE, OKLAHOMA, THAT

Section 1: The area which the petition seeks annexation is described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the Easterly Right-of-Way of the Missouri-Pacific Railroad (old Midland Valley Railroad) intersects the Northerly Right-of-Way of S.H. 165 (Peak Blvd.), the existing City Limits of Muskogee; Thence Easterly along the Northerly Right-of-Way of S.H. 165 (Peak Blvd.) to the Easterly Right-of-Way of Cherokee Drive (old Hwy 64); Thence Northeasterly along the Easterly Right-of-Way of Cherokee Drive (old Hwy 64) to the Easterly Right-of-Way of the Missouri-Pacific Railroad (old Midland Valley Railroad); Thence Southwesterly along said Easterly Right-of-Way of the Missouri-Pacific Railroad to the Point of Beginning.


Section 2: The increase of the City by the annexation of the hereinbefore described property will redound to the benefit of the City and the same is hereby annexed.

Section 3: A copy of the Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed, a copy of which is attached, certified by the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Muskogee County, Oklahoma.

Section 4: SEVERABILITY. Should any section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase hereof be held invalid, void, or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not render invalid, void, or unconstitutional any other section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, and the same are deemed severable for this purpose.

Section 5: EMERGENCY. This Ordinance being designated to protect the health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Muskogee, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.
