AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY ADJACENT TO THE CITY LIMITS UPON PETITION OF THE OWNER, SAID TERRITORY BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PART OF THE N/2 OF THE SW/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, MUSKOGEE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: STARTING AT THE NW CORNER OF SAID SW/4; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 508.81 FEET; THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST 2131.61 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°38'25" WEST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°05'46" WEST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 26.22 ACRES, MORE OR LESS; AND A PART OF THE N/2 OF THE SW/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, MUSKOGEE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: STARTING AT THE NW CORNER OF SAID SW/4; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 508.81; THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST 2131.61 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 627.02 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°38'25" WEST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°05'46" WEST A DISTANCE OF 627.02 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONTAINING 23.79 ACRES, MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (CHARLES A. TADLOCK, JOHNNY M. TADLOCK, JERRY R. JAMES AND BLANCH FAYE JAMES, PETITIONERS)

WHEREAS, the owners of the acres described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, said land being contiguous to and adjacent to the City of Muskogee, have requested in writing that the same be annexed to and added to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE, OKLAHOMA, THAT:

Section 1: The area by which the petition seeks annexation is described as follows:

A PART OF THE N/2 OF THE SW/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, MUSKOGEE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: STARTING AT THE NW CORNER OF SAID SW/4; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A

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DISTANCE OF 508.81 FEET; THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST 2131.61 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°38'25" WEST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°05'46" WEST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 26.22 ACRES, MORE OR LESS; AND A PART OF THE N/2 OF THE SW/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, MUSKOGEE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: STARTING AT THE NW CORNER OF SAID SW/4; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 508.81; THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST 2131.61 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 691.47 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH 00°05'46" EAST A DISTANCE OF 627.02 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°38'25" WEST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°05'46" WEST A DISTANCE OF 627.02 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89°38'25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 1652 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONTAINING 23.79 ACRES, MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (CHARLES A. TADLOCK, JOHNNY M. TADLOCK, JERRY R. JAMES AND BLANCH FAYE JAMES, PETITIONERS)

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Section 2: The increase of the City by the annexation of the hereinbefore described property will rebound to the benefit of the City and the same is hereby annexed.

Section 3: A copy of the Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed, a copy of which is attached, certified by the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Muskogee County, Oklahoma.

Section 4: SEVERABILITY. Should any section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase hereof be held invalid, void, or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not render invalid, void, or unconstitutional any other section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, and the same are deemed severable for this purpose.

Section 5: EMERGENCY. This Ordinance being designated to protect the health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Muskogee, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.



