

CITY OF OILTON ORDINANCE

Number 133

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OILTON, OKLAHOMA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTIES, MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, IN SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, CREEK COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma be and the same are hereby extended to include the following described properties, situated in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land situated in the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 33, Township 19 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, more particularly described as Beginning at a point 1032 feet North of the SW/4 of said Section 33, Township 19 North, Range 7 East, Thence North a distance of 201 feet; thence East a distance of 272.5 feet; thence South a distance of 201 feet; Thence west a distance of 272.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.095 acres more or less.


SECTION 2: The governing body finds that the above described tract is adjacent to, contiguous to, or abutting on the boundaries of Oilton, Oklahoma, and that pursuant to 11 O. S. §21-105, more than three quarters (3/4) in value of the owners of the real property above described, have petitioned the City of Oilton for annexation of the above described property. Further, there are no registered voters residing or registered within the above described real property.

SECTION 3: That publication of notice of the presentation of the petition has been made by publication in the Drumright Gusher, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Oilton, for two successive weeks, prior to the date hereof.

SECTION 4: That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy hereof to be filed and recorded in the Office of the County Clerk of Creek County, Oklahoma, along with a map or plat of the annexed property.


SECTION 5: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma and its inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this ordinance be put into full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
