**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OILTON, OKLAHOMA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTIES, MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, IN SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, CREEK COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the governing body of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the corporate limits of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma be and the same are hereby extended to include the following described properties, situated in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land beginning at the Southeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 19 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, Creek County, State of Oklahoma, Thence West 200 feet; thence North 152 feet; thence West 235 feet; thence North 94 feet; thence West 32 feet; thence South 246 feet; thence West 593 feet; thence North 1250 feet; thence East 400 feet to the Northeast Corner of the NW/4 of the SE/4 of the NW/4 of said Section 32; thence South 134.5 feet; thence East 660 feet to the East Boundary of the NW/4 of said Section 32, thence South 1185.5 to the Southeast Corner of the NW/4 of said Section 32, the same being the point of beginning.

**SECTION 2:** The governing body finds that the above described tract is adjacent to, contiguous to, or abutting on the boundaries of Oilton, Oklahoma, and that pursuant to 11 O. S. §21-103, that the owners of a majority of the acres of the above described real property have consented to the annexation thereof. Further, the governing body finds that in fact 100 percent of the owners thereof have consented to the annexation thereof.


**SECTION 3:** That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy hereof to be filed and recorded in the Office of the County Clerk of Creek County, Oklahoma, along with a map or plat of the annexed property.

**SECTION 4:** It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma and its inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this ordinance be put into full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

**ADOPTED** this 10th day of January, 2002, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the governing body of the City of Oilton, in compliance with the Open Meeting Act, 25 O.S. Section 301, et seq.
