AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OILTON, OKLAHOMA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTIES, MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, IN SECTIONS 32 AND 33, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN AND SECTIONS 3 AND 4, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, ALL IN CREEK COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the City of Oilton, Oklahoma be and the same are hereby extended to include the following described properties, situated in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract located in the SW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 32, Township 19 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, Creek County, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest Corner of the SW/4 of the SE/4, thence South 711.2 feet; thence East 212.5 feet, thence North 416 feet, thence East 82.7 feet; thence North 295.2 feet; thence West 295.2 feet to the point of beginning; and,

A tract located in the W/2 of Lot 4 in Section 3, Township 18 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, Creek County, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 792 feet North of the Southwest Corner of said Lot 4, thence North 567.6 feet to the Northwest Corner of said W/2 of said Lot 4, thence East 330 feet, thence South 567.6 feet, thence West 330 feet to the point of beginning; and,

A tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point 1,113.56 feet East of the Southwest Corner of the SW/4 of Section 33, Township 19 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, Creek County, State of Oklahoma; thence North 504 feet; thence West 205.84 feet; thence North 215.9 feet; thence East 150 feet; thence North 1,575.5 feet, more or less to a point 344.6 feet South of the North line of the SW/4 of said Section 33; thence East 797.4 feet, thence North 345 feet, more or less to the North line of the SW/4; thence East along the North line of said SW/4 3528 feet, more or less to the Northeast Corner of the SE/4 of said Section 33; thence South along the East line of the SE/4 of said Section 24, 2,640 feet, more or less to the Southeast Corner of the SE/4 of said Section 24; thence West 4,166.44 feet, more or less to the point of beginning; and,


A tract of land situated in the SW/4 of Section 33, Township 19 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, more particularly described as Beginning at a point 430 feet North of the SW/4 of said Section 33, Township 19 North, Range 7 East, Thence North 1053 feet; thence East 654 feet; thence South 893.1 feet; Thence West 300 feet; thence South 159.9 feet; thence West 354 feet to the point of beginning; and,

A tract of land situated in the NW/4 of Section 4, Township 18 North, Range 7 East of the Indian Meridian, Creek County, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as Beginning at a the Northwest Corner of the NE/4 of the NW/4 of said Section 4, thence East 316 feet; thence South 330.81 feet; thence West 601.93 feet; thence North 280.81 feet; thence East 285.93 feet; thence North 50 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The governing body finds that the above described tract is adjacent to, contiguous to, or abutting on the boundaries of Oilton, Oklahoma, and that pursuant to 11 O. S. §21-103, that the owners of a majority of the acres of the above described real property have consented to the annexation thereof. Further, the governing body finds that in fact 100 percent of the owners thereof have consented to the annexation thereof.

SECTION 3: That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy hereof to be filed and recorded in the Office of the County Clerk of Creek County, Oklahoma, along with a map or plat of the annexed property.

ADOPTED this 25th day of April, 2002, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the governing body of the City of Oilton, in compliance with the Open Meeting Act, 25 O.S. Section 301, et seq.
