ORDINANCE NO. 355

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE OF CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA, AND FOR THE DE-ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA;

SECTION I: The following described real property is hereby de-annexed and excluded from the corporate limits of the City of Prague:

A tract of land described as beginning 660 feet South of the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter, thence West 5280 feet, thence South 66 feet, thence East 5280 feet, thence North 66 feet to the point of beginning, Sec 30, Township 12 North, Range 6 East, Lincoln County, Oklahoma.

SECTION II-EMERGENCY CLAUSE:


It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and welfare of the City of Prague, and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
