

ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA, AS SET FORTH BELOW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION I: The owners of a majority of the whole number of acres of the tracts and property, premises, lands and territory hereinafter described having made and executed a consent in writing that the said tracts, property, premises, lands and territory shall be added and annexed to the city limits of the City of Prague, Oklahoma, the same being situated in Lincoln County, Oklahoma, and adjacent to or adjoining the city limits of said City, and being more particularly described as follows:


A tract of land lying entirely within the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 12 North, Range 5 East, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13; thence North 900 feet; West 330 feet; South 900 feet; thence East 330 feet to the Point of Beginning.

SECTION II - EMERGENCY CLAUSE: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and welfare of the City of Prague, and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Passed and approval, with the Emergency Clause having been voted upon separately, this 12th day of August, 2002.


