

ORDINANCE NO. 423

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AND PROPERTY TO THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS PURSUANT TO TITLE 11 OF THE OKLAHOMA STATUTES; DESCRIBING SAID PROPERTY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described property located adjacent to the present boundaries of the City of Prague, Oklahoma:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section 36, Township 12 North, Range 5 East of the Indian Meridian, Lincoln County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 36; Thence West (S 89°23,51" W) along the north boundary of said Section 36 a distance of 627.00 feet; Thence South (S 00°14'07" E) and parallel to the east boundary of said Section 36 a distance of 1450.00 feet; Thence East (N 89°23'51" E) a distance of 627.00 feet to a point on the east boundary of said section 36; Thence North (N 00°14'07" W) a distance of 1450.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; less and except a 34 foot strip running North and South along the East boundary of said Section 36; and less and except an 81 foot strip running East and West along the South boundary of the above described parcel; and less and except, an 81 foot strip running North and South along the West boundary of the above described parcel.




SECTION 2. REPEALER. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




