

ORDINANCE 2004-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF RED OAK, LATIMER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, ADDING TO SAID TOWN CERTAIN TERRITORY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF RED OAK, OKLAHOMA THAT:

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the Town of Red Oak, that certain property adjacent to the city limits be added to the town; and

WHEREAS, the trustees of the Town of Red Oak has held a public hearing on the annexation, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Red Oak, in its discretion, has decided that certain territory adjacent to the town should be added to the town because it would rebound to the benefit of the town.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF RED OAK, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1: That the town limits of the Town of Red Oak, Oklahoma, shall constitute and include within the limits of said town, the following described real property, to-wit:

All that part of the NE ¼ of Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 21 East, lying and being north of U.S. Highway 270
and

All that part of the W ½ NW ¼ of Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 21 East, lying and being north of U.S. Highway 270 and West of Highway 82, all in Latimer County, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2: The plan of service to the above described property is hereby made a part of this ordinance and a copy attached hereto.

SECTION 3: Emergency Clause

That an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety by reason whereof it is necessary that this act take effect immediately and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED and the EMERGENCY CLAUSE ruled on separately this 11th day of October, 2004.
