


ORDINANCE NO. 99-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-1, ANNEXING LANDS ADJACENT TO THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SALINA, MAYES COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, WHICH HAVE BEEN DESCRIBED AS THE CHEROKEE NATION SALINA COMMUNITY CLINIC.

At the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Salina, it was brought to the Board's attention that the legal description of the Cherokee Nation Salina Community Clinic is in error and should be amended to show corrected legal description.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Town of Board of Trustees of Salina, Oklahoma, that Ordinance No. 98-1, Annexing Lands Adjacent to the Town Limits of the Town of Salina, Mayes County, Oklahoma, which have been described as the Cherokee Nation Salina Community Clinic be amended to reflect the corrected legal description as follows:

A tract of land containing 9.78 acres, more or less, located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 20 East, I.B. & M., being described as follows: Commencing at the SW corner of the NW/4 of said Section 14; thence South 89 degrees 27' 39" East a distance of 545.47 feet to a point on the East right-of-way line of Oklahoma Highway #82; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line on a curve to the right having a radius of 5664.58 feet a distance of 20.26 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 89 degrees 27' 39" East a distance of 736.04 feet; thence North 00 degrees 01' 00" West a distance of 639.01 feet; thence North 89 degrees 27' 39" West a distance of 584.92 feet to a point on the East right-of-way line of Oklahoma Highway #82; thence Southwesterly along said right-of-way line on a curve to the left having a radius of 5664.58 feet, a distance of 655.58 feet to the Point of Beginning, the South 30 feet thereof is reserved for an water line easement.



Done for and on behalf of the Town of Salina its duly elected/appointed Board of Trustees on the date as above shown.






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
