AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA, BY ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY, DESIGNATING THE TRACT TO BE ANNEXED; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS OF THIS ORDINANCE ARE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE, THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Sapulpa, after proper notice required by statute and upon due consideration, finds that the following described area of land is adjacent or contiguous to property already within the municipal limits and that the required number of owners and voters have petitioned the City to become annexed into municipal limits; and that annexation of the land is authorized by the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma.

Section 2. The Corporate Limits of the City of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, shall be and the same are extended to include the following described land situated in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A strip of land situated in Creek County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as:
The North 24.75 Feet of the West Half of the West Half of
the West Half of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter
(W/2 W/2 W/2 N/2 NE/4 NE/4) of Section Nine (9),
Township Eighteen North (18N), Range Twelve East (12E), and
the North 24.75 Feet of the East Half of the West Half of the
West Half of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter (E/2 W/2 W/2 N/2 NE/4 NE/4) of Section Nine (9),
Township Eighteen North (18N), Range Twelve East (12E)
Creek County, State of Oklahoma .

Upon annexation, the above-described property shall be included in and considered a part of Ward 5 of the City of Sapulpa and shall retain its pre-annexation zoning of "Agricultural land" post-annexation.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any part or parts of this ordinance are held invalid or ineffective, the remaining portion shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. EMERGENCY. Being immediately necessary that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
