NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sayre, Oklahoma, that the Howard Addition to the City of Sayre, Oklahoma be and the same is hereby disconnected and excluded from the City of Sayre, Oklahoma.

or objection of anynature being made to the application of petitioners the Court after hearing the evidence of petitioners in support of their application finds that due and proper notice of the hearing of said application has been given as provided by law that the allegations as set forth in the petition filed in this cause are true and that petitioners are entitled to the relief as prayed for.

It is therefore the order, Judgment and decree of the Court that all that part of the Howard Addition to the town of Sayre, Okla., consisting of Lots, Blocks Streets and Alleys and hereinafter described be and the same are hereby vacated, to-wit:

Blocks 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, Twelfth Street, all of that part of Eleventh Street South of Blocks six and Seven, Maple Street, Cedar Street, all of that part of Locust Street lying and being west of its intersection with Tenth Street, all that part of Elm Street west of Blocks 15 and 18, *all of pine street lying and being west of blocks 15 and 18*, all of that part of Malberry and Ash Streets lying and being west of their intersection with Eleventh Street, all the Alleys running along and thru the above described Blocks.

That said above described Blocks, Streets and parts thereof and said Alleys be and the same are vacated and the proprietors and owners of said property are authorized and empowered to enclose the same as tho they were never platted.

Now on this the 5th day of August 1918 the same being one of the regular Judicial days of the August 1918 term of this Court the above entitled action came on regularly to be heard and the petitioners appearing in person and by Counsel and it appearing to the Court, and it is so found by the Court, that due and proper legal notice of the presentation of this matter has been given by publication and by posting as provided by law and the Court after hearing the evidence of the petitioners in said cause and no protest or objections being made or filed against the granting of the prayer in this matter, the Court after being fully advised in the premises and upon consideration finds that petitioners are entitled to the relief as prayed for.

It is therefore the order, Judgment and decree of the Court that all that part and parcel of the Howard Addition to the town of Sayre, Oklahoma, as shown by the recorded plat thereof, consisting of the following described Lots, Blocks Streets and Alleys in said Addition to-wit:

Blocks 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, and 24.

All that part of Eleventh street lying South of Blocks six and Seven, all of Locust Street, all of Elm Street, All of Pine Street Except that part lying between Blocks 9 and 16, all of Tenth Street except that part lying between Blocks 9 and 10, All of Malberry Street and All of Ash Streets together with all Alleys running along and thru said Blocks, be and they are hereby vacated and the proprietors and owners thereof are empowered and authorized to enclose same as tho they had never been platted.


