

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AND PROPERTY OUTSIDE THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, OKLAHOMA, PURSUANT TO TITLE 11 OF THE OKLAHOMA STATUTES; DESCRIBING SAID PROPERTY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ~~DECLARING AN EMERGENCY~~:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the provisions of applicable law, the following described property located outside the present boundaries of the City of Shawnee, Oklahoma:

A PARCEL OF LAND LYING IN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER (SW/C) OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 10N, RANGE 4 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN POTTAWATOMIE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER (SW/C) OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 10N, RANGE 4 EAST; THENCE S88°11'20"E 835.16 FEET; THENCE NORTH 690 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE NORTH 1972.15 FEET; THENCE S88°58'23E 1815.10 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 1952.59 FEET; THENCE N89°35'26"W 1815.10 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

is hereby annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Shawnee, Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of law applicable thereto and assigned a zoning classification of RE; Rural Estates District.

Section 2. That the "City Map of the City of Shawnee, Oklahoma" be amended accordingly to reflect said annexation and zoning classification.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That the provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this ordinance.

~~Section 5. That for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.~~
