

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE AREAS OR TRACTS INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS HEREOF BE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE EFFECTED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES BY THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma, be and the same are hereby extended to include therein the following described tract of land:

A part of the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 22, T9N, R25E of the Indian Base and Meridian, Leflore County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the NW corner of said W/2 NE; thence South 02 degrees 00 minutes 20 seconds East along the West line of said W/2 NE a distance of 1262.40 feet; thence North 87 degrees 59 minutes 40 seconds East a distance of 302.86 feet to the True point of beginning; thence North 88 degrees 14 minutes 46 seconds East a distance of 250.00 feet; thence South 01 degrees 45 minutes 20 seconds East a distance of 176.40 feet; thence South 88 degrees 14 minutes 46 seconds West a distance of 250.00 feet; thence North 01 degrees 45 minutes 20 seconds West a distance of 176.40 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The Town Board of Trustees find that the above described area is adjacent and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3: That the excess of 75% of the registered voters living on the annexed territory have approved of the annexation and have joined in the petition to annex.

SECTION 4: That in excess of 75% of the owners in value of the land begin annexed have approved of the annexation and have joined in the Petition for Annexation.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


