

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE AREAS OR TRACTS INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS HEREOF BE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE EFFECTED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES BY THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma, be and the same are hereby extended to include therein the following described tract of land:

The NW/4 of the NE/4 of Section 22, T9N, R25E of the Indian Base and Meridian, LeFlore County, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2: The Town Board of Trustees find that the above described area is adjacent and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3: That 100% of the registered voters living on the annexed territory have approved of the annexation and have joined in the petition to annex.

SECTION 4: That 100% of the owners in value of the land begin annexed have approved of the annexation and have joined in the Petition for Annexation.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any part or parts shall be held invalid or ineffective, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining part or parts of the ordinance.

SECTION 7: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason hereof this




