AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CHANGING OF THE WARD BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF SPIRO PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND DESIGNATION OF NEW WARDS AND THEIR BOUNDARIES.

SECTION 1: This Ordinance shall become a part of the existing Ordinance No. 92-05 of the Incorporated Town of Spiro. To the extent that there may be any conflict between this and Ordinance No. 92-05 and any other previous ordinance, this ordinance shall be dominant and controlling.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be effective on and after November 14, 2002.

SECTION 3: That the wards of the Town of Spiro shall have the following boundaries and be designated as follows:

WARD 1: All that area South of U.S. Highway #271 and East of the following described line: Beginning at a point where the Kansas City Southern Railway intersects the South corporate limits line; thence continuing Northeasterly to Ash Avenue; thence North on Ash Avenue to South 5<sup>th</sup> Street; thence West on South 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Main Street; thence North on Main Street to U.S. Highway #271.

WARD 2: All that area North of U. S. Highway #271 and East of the following described line: Beginning at a point where Beech Avenue intersects U. S. Highway #271 and continuing North on Beech Avenue to North 6<sup>th</sup> Street; thence West on North 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Ash Avenue; thence North on Ash Avenue to the corporate limits.

WARD 3: All that area North of U. S. Highway #271 and West of the following described line: Beginning where Columbus Avenue intersects U. S. Highway #271 and continuing North on Columbus Avenue to North 4<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East on North 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Boston Avenue; thence North on Boston Avenue to North 5<sup>th</sup> Street; thence West on North 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Columbus Avenue; thence North on Columbus Avenue to 9<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East to the corporate limits.

WARD 4: All that area North of U. S. Highway #271 and West of the following described line: Beginning at a point where U. S. Highway #271 intersects with Beech Avenue and continuing North on Beech Avenue to North 6<sup>th</sup> Street; thence West on North 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Ash Avenue; thence North on Ash Avenue to the corporate limits and east of the following described line: Beginning at a point where U. S. Highway #271 intersects with Columbus Avenue; thence North on Columbus Avenue to North 4<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East on North 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Boston Avenue; thence North on Boston Avenue to North 5<sup>th</sup> Street; thence West on North 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Columbus Avenue; thence North on Columbus Avenue to 9<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East to corporate limits; thence East and South along corporate limits to

Ash Street; thence South on Ash Street to North 6<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East on North 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Beech Street; thence South on Beech Street to Highway #271.

WARD 5: All that area South of U. S. Highway #271 and West of the following described line: Beginning at a point where Main Street intersects with U. S. Highway #271 and continuing South on Main Street to South 4<sup>th</sup> Street; thence East of South 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Ash Avenue; thence South on Ash Avenue to the Kansas City Southern Railway; thence Southwesterly along the Kansas City Southern Railway to the corporate limits.
