AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE AREAS OR TRACTS INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS HEREOF BE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE EFFECTED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES BY THE TOWN OF SPIRO, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma, be and the same are hereby extended to include therein the following described tracts of land:

Tract 1: Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Wyndlake Addition, an addition to Leflore County, Oklahoma. (Platted from part of the E/2 of the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 15, T9N, R25E.)

And

Tract 2: Lot 5, Wyndlake Addition, an addition to Leflore County, Oklahoma. (Platted from part of the E/2 of the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 15, T9N, R25E.)

SECTION 2: The Town Board of Trustees find that the above described area is adjacent and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the Town of Spiro, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3: That there are no registered voters living on the annexed territory.

SECTION 4: That in excess of three-fourths of the owners in value of the land begin annexed have approved of the annexation and have joined in the Petition for Annexation.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any part or parts shall be held invalid or ineffective, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining part or parts of the ordinance.


