AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF STROUD, OKLAHOMA AND DESIGNATING THE AREA OR TRACT INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS HEREOF BE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STROUD, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the corporate limits of the City of Stroud, Oklahoma, shall be and the same are hereby extended to include the following described land situated in Lincoln County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 15 North, Range 6 East of the I. M., being described as:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of said Northeast Quarter; Thence South 00°00' East along the section line a distance of 1340 feet; Thence North 90°00' West a distance of 740 feet; Thence North 0°00' West a distance of 1220 feet; Thence North 26°00' East a distance of 143.8 feet to the North line of said Northeast Quarter; Thence South 89°13' East along the section line a distance of 677 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Said Tract contains 22.8 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. The Council finds that the above described area is adjacent and contiguous to the present corporate limits of said City and that such annexation has been consented to in writing by owners of a majority of the whole number of acres owned by residents of the said territory to be annexed; and that the annexation of said area is authorized by the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, and in particular by Sections 21-102 and 21-103 of Title 11 O.S. 2001 as supplemented.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. If any part or parts hereof be held invalid or ineffective the remaining portions shall not be affected.


