ORDINANCE NO. 219

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Town of TISHOMINGO, Oklahoma, to Include Certain Tracts Hereinafter Described and Annexing the same to Said Town of TISHOMINGO, OKLAHOMA, as a Part Thereof, Declaring an Emergency and for Other Purposes.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Tishomingo, Oklahoma:

Section 1, That the corporate limits of the Town of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, is hereby extended and defined to include the following described tracts and parcels of lands which are adjacent and contiguous to the present territory of the said Town of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots 3 and 4 and N/2 of SE/4 of NW/4 and E/2 of SE/4 of NW/4 and W/2 of W/2 of SE/4 and E/2 of SW/4 in Section 3;

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 in Section 4;

Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval  
and publication as required by law.
