

TOWN OF VERA, OKLAHOMA
ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 1

*AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY INTO THE MUNICIPAL
LIMITS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
VERA, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The following territory is annexed into the municipal limits of the Town of
Vera, Oklahoma:


Beginning at the municipal limits of the Town of Vera at the
Northwest corner of Sec. 25-T23N-R13E, Washington County,
Oklahoma, a 70-foot wide tract of land more specifically described
as the North 70 feet of Sections 26 and 27 and the West 70 feet of
Sections 22 and 15 and the North 70 feet of Sections 15, 14, and 13
all in T23N-R13E; and the North 70 feet of Sections 18, 17, and 16
and the East 70 feet of Sections 16, 21, 28, and 33 and the South 70
feet of Sections 33, 32, and 31 all in T23N-R14E; and the South 70
feet of Sections 36, 35, 34, 33, 32 and 31 and the West 70 feet of
Sections 31, 30, 19, and 18 and the North 70 feet of Sections 18 and
17 and the North 70 feet of Section 16 to the West edge of State right
of way line of U. S. Highway 75 and the East 70 feet of Section 16
immediately West of the West edge of State right of way line of U.
S. Highway 75 and the South 70 feet of Section 16 West of the West
edge of State right of way line of U. S. Highway 75 to 70 feet West
of the Southeast corner of the SW/4 of the SE/4 of the SW/4 of
Section 16 and the East 70 feet of the NW/4 of the NE/4 of the
NW/4 to 70 feet South of the Southeast corner of the NW/4 of the
NE/4 of the NW/4 and the North 70 feet of the SE/4 of the NE/4 of
the NW/4 and the East 70 feet of the SE/4 of the NE/4 of the NW/4
and the SE/4 of the NW/4 and the NE/4 of the SW/4 to 70 feet South
of the Southeast corner of the NE/4 of the SW/4 and the North 70
feet of the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 21 all in T23N-R13E.

Section 2: The Town of Vera will extend new services to the annexed territory as adjacent
properties are annexed into the Town and capital improvement plans are developed, these plans to
be developed and implemented in the time allowed by law.

Section 3: It being necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and public
welfare of the citizens of the Town of Vera, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for
which reason this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication.


PASSED and the emergency clause voted upon separately, and approved in regular session
