AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF VERDIGRIS, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a municipal governing body by ordinance may add to the municipality territory adjacent or contiguous to its corporate limits and increase or diminish the corporate limits as the governing body deems desirable for the benefit of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Verdigris, Oklahoma (the "Board"), proposes to annex certain territory into the corporate limits of the Town of Verdigris, Oklahoma (the "Town"), pursuant to the specific provisions of Title 11 O.S. §§ 21-101 and 21-104, and for the reasons set forth herein;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has held a public hearing and took public comment regarding the annexation of the property annexed herein;

WHEREAS, the proposed territory is adjacent and contiguous to the Town, receives the same services as all other similar areas of the Town, and will continue to receive such services by the same methods and/or means;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that all the requisites to annexing the territory have been satisfied and met, all as required by law;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the Town to annex the aforementioned territory;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF VERDIGRIS, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1: That, pursuant to the laws made and provided by the State of Oklahoma the real property hereinafter described may be lawfully annexed to the Town and, henceforth for all purposes, considered a part of the Town.

Section 2: That the following described real property and premises, situated in Rogers County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Town of Verdigris, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Part of the NE/4 of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 16 East of the I.B.&M., Rogers County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the N/2 of NE/4 of said Section 30; thence North 0°03'30" West along the West line of the NE/4 of said Section 30, a distance of 60.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 89°16'39" East a distance of 253.75 feet to a point; thence North 20°24'08" East a distance of 304.96 feet to a point; thence North 62°57'00" West a distance of 250.00 feet to a point on the Easterly Right-of-Way line of U.S. Highway 66; thence South 27°03'00" West along the Easterly Right-of-Way line of U.S. Highway 66, a distance of 302.04 feet to a point on the West line of the NE/4 of said Section 30; thence South 0°03'30" East

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along the West line of the NE/4 of said Section 30, a distance of 143.40 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.24 acres more or less. LESS AND EXCEPT the South 60 feet thereof for roadway.

Section 3: That there shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Rogers County, Oklahoma, a true and certified copy of this Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory hereby annexed.


Section 4: If any section, subsection or sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision or decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: The Service Plan for Extending Services to Territory Proposed for Annexation adopted by the Town Board and on file with the Town Clerk is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.


Section 6. For the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and by reason whereof this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
