

Ordinance #04-0203

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE TOWN OF WARNER, OKLAHOMA, CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO JOE N. AND NEVA JOHNSON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WARNER, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1.

That Joe N. and Neva Johnson are the owners of the following described property situated in Muskogee County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land in the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 20, Township 12 North, Range 19 East of the Indian Meridian, more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of the North half of the SE ¼ 324.56 feet west of the southeast corner thereof, said point being on the west right of way of U.S. Highway 64; thence south 76.5 feet more or less to the north line of Ranch Acres; thence west along the north line of Ranch Acres 273.22 feet; thence north 76.5 feet more or less to the south line of the north half of the SE ¼; thence East along the south line of the north half of the SE ¼ 273.22 feet to the point of beginning.

And that Joe N. and Neva Johnson have made a request to the Town of Warner, Oklahoma to annex said property and to extend the boundaries of the town to include said property.

SECTION 2.

The above described real estate adjoins the present Town limits of the Town of Warner, Oklahoma, and this Council finds that it is in the best interest of the said Town that the above described real estate be annexed to the Town of Warner, Oklahoma, and that the boundaries of the Town of Warner, Oklahoma, be extended to include said real estate.


SECTION 3.


SECTION 4.
