

ORDINANCE NO. 1995-4

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD, CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BY ANNEXING THERETO THE THE TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED: PROVIDING THAT INVALIDITY OF A PART SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE REMAINDER: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma:

Section I. That the city limits of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, are hereby declared to be changed, to the extent of, and for the purpose of including within said City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, that piece, parcel or tract of land described as follows:

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in part of the West One-half of Southwest Quarter (W/2 SW/4) of Section 9, Township Twelve North (12N), Range Fourteen West (14W) of the Indian Meridian; said parcel of land being described by metes and bounds as follows: BEGINNING at a point 33 feet East of the West line and 1566.7 feet South of the North line of W/2 SW/4, thence East a distance of 17 feet, thence North on a line parallel to and 50 feet East of said West line a distance of 94 feet, thence South 80 degrees 38' East a distance of 38.7 feet, thence Southeasterly on a curve to the left having a radius of 1502.9 feet, a distance of 342.3 feet, thence South 23 degrees 38' East a distance of 50 feet to a point on the North property line of the C.R.I. & P. Railroad Company, thence Southwesterly alinf said property line a distance of 455.4 feet to a point 33 feet East of the West line of said W/2 of SW/4, thence North on a line parallel to and 35 feet East of said West line a distance 157 feet to a point of beginning, containing 1.635 acres more or less.

Section II. The above described land is hereby annexed to, and made apart of the City of Weatherford, Custer County, Oklahoma, purauant to consent and Petition of Sandra King Ross and Donald King, who are the owner of the land.

Section III. Should any part of this Ordinance be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or be held to be invalid with reference to any part, parcel or portion of the land above described, such holding shall not affect the balidity of said Ordinance with reference to the remiander of said Ordinance or of said land.

Section IV. All ordinannces in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Section V. It being necessary for the perservation of the public peace, health safety, and general welfare of said City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this ORDinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
