

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD, CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BY ANNEXING THERETO THE TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED: PROVIDING THAT INVALIDITY OF A PART SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE REMAINDER: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma:

Section I. That the City limits of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, are hereby declared to be changed, to the extent of, and for the purpose of including within said City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, the following pieces, parcels or tracts of land described as:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: (A)

A tract of land located in the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 13 North, Range 14 W.I.M., Custer County, Oklahoma, described as: BEGINNING at a point 2060.0 feet South and 607.78 feet East of the NW/Corner of Section 34; thence North 220 feet; thence East 339.18 feet; thence South 220 feet; thence West 339.18 feet to the point of beginning,

and

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: (B)

A tract of land located in the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 13 North, Range 14 W.I.M., described as: BEGINNING at a point 2040.0 feet South of the NW/Corner of Section 34, thence East 607.78; thence South 20 feet; thence West 607.78 feet; thence North 20 feet to the point of beginning,

and

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: (C)

A tract of land located in the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 13 North, Range 14 W.I.M., described as: BEGINNING at a point 2040.0 feet South and 217.8 feet East of the NW/Corner of Section 34; thence North 200 feet; thence East 389.98 feet; thence South 200 feet; thence West 389.98 feet to the point of beginning.

Section II. That said annexed land is declared to be zoned A-1(General Agricultural District.

Section III. The above described land is hereby annexed to, and made a part of the City of Weatherford, Custer County, Oklahoma, pursuant to consent and petition of Calvary Baptist Church, the owner of the respective tracts of land.

Section IV. Should any part of this Ordinance be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or be held to be invalid with reference to any part, parcel or portion of the land above described, such holding shall not affect the validity of said Ordinance with reference to the remainder of said Ordinance or of said land.

Section V. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Section VI. It being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health safety, and general welfare of said City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.


