

Exhibit to Ordinance 2015-06
R-1 Rural Residential Estates

The following territory is hereby zoned and placed in the R-1 Rural Residential Estates Zoning District of the Town of Goldsby:

NE/4 of Section 28, Township 8 North, Range 3 West of the I.M. in McClain County, Oklahoma, LESS AND EXCEPT, HOWEVER, the territory zoned and placed in the C-1 General Commercial Zoning District of the Town of Goldsby as described in the Exhibit to this Ordinance 2015-06 labeled C-1 General Commercial.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 6

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD, CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, BY ANNEXING THERETO THE TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED; PROVIDING THAT INVALIDITY OF A PART SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE REMAINDER; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma:

Section I. That the City limits of the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, are hereby declared to be changed, to the extent of, and for the purpose of including within said City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, the following pieces, parcels or tracts of land described as:

That portion of the Interstate I-40 right-of-way running East and West through the City of Weatherford, Custer County, State of Oklahoma, which is bordered by Exit No. 80 on the western most end and bordered by Milepost No. 85 on the eastern most end of said Interstate I-40 right-of-way.

Section II. That said annexed land is declared to be zoned: C-3.

Section III. The above described land is hereby annexed to, and made a part of the City of Weatherford, Custer County, Oklahoma, are declared to be changed, to the extent of, and for the purpose of including within the City of Weatherford, Oklahoma, the above described right-of-way which is adjacent or contiguous to property already within the municipal limits of the City of Weatherford on three sides and is therefore eligible for annexation pursuant to Oklahoma Statutes and the Weatherford City Code.

Section IV. Should any part of this Ordinance be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or be held to be invalid with reference to any part, parcel or portion of the land above described, such holding shall not affect the validity of said Ordinance with reference to the remainder of said Ordinance or of said land.

Section V. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.


EMERGENCY CLAUSE


