ORDINANCE NO. 75  
An ordinance adding and annexing to the town of Westville, Oklahoma, certain tracts of land adjacent to the city limits of the town of Westville with more than one residence hereinafter described and declared an emergency.

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE  
Whereas the hereinafter named tracts of land hereinafter described and adjacent to the city limits of the town of Westville with more than one residence, should be annexed to the city limits of the town of Westville, Oklahoma; and  
WHEREAS the city council of the town of Westville, Oklahoma, deems it proper to annex the hereinafter described tracts of land and that such annexation will rebound to the benefit of said city.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the city council of the town of Westville, Oklahoma:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described tracts of land, be, and the same are hereby added to, and annexed to the city limits of the town of Westville, Oklahoma, and incorporated in the town of Westville, Oklahoma, to-wit:

a. That portion of Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 26 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, described as follows:

The south five acres of the north west ten acres of Lot one and the north one-half of north, west one-fourth of south east one-fourth of north east one-fourth of Section 1, Township 17, Range 25 east.

The west 315 and the north 115 feet of the east 345 feet and the south 75 feet of the north 180 feet of the east 345 feet of the south east one-fourth of north east one-fourth of north east one-fourth of Section 1, Township 17, Range 25 east.

b. That portion of Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 26 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, described as follows:

South 130 feet of north 260 feet of west 165 feet of west one-half south west, south east, south west.

South 270 feet of east 90 feet of west 165 feet of south west, south east, south west.

South 130 feet of north 390 feet of west 165 feet of south west, south east, south west.

East 140 feet of south east, south west, south west, south west.

West 132 feet of east 234 feet of south west, south west, south west.

North 150 feet of south 208 feet of west 130 feet of east one-half south west, south east, south west, and north 54 feet of south 208 feet of east 100 feet of west 290 feet of east one-half south west, south east, south west.

North 70 feet of the east 90 feet of the west 165 feet of the south 270 feet of the south west one-fourth of south east one-fourth south west one-fourth of Section 31 Township 18 North, Range 26.

North 130.00 feet of the west one-half of west one-half of south west one-fourth of south east one-fourth south west one-fourth of Section 31 Township 18 North, Range 26 east, of the Indian Bas Meridian.

Section 2 - EMERGENCY: that by reason of the fact that the above described tracts of land are without police protection, fire protection, and sanitation, it is deemed and hereby declared

NECESSARY for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, that said territory above described should be annexed without delay to that and this ordinance shall be effective immediately.

ADOPTED by the City Council of Westville, Oklahoma, on this 1st day of January, 1986.
