## **Treasurer Opens E-mail for Tax Rebate Help**

**OKLAHOMA CITY** – State Treasurer Scott Meacham today announced a special email address for help with tax rebate checks. The address is [rebate@treasurer.ok.gov](mailto:rebate@treasurer.ok.gov).

“We are receiving hundreds of phone calls from people needing help with their tax rebate checks,” Meacham said. “Unfortunately, many callers have had trouble getting through because of the volume of calls. We have created this new email address to help get messages to us.”

Meacham said taxpayers who have problems with their rebate checks or who have not received a rebate check can send an email to [rebate@treasurer.ok.gov](mailto:rebate@treasurer.ok.gov). “Please include your name and a phone number where you can be reached during the day,” he said. “Also, please tell us your question or problem.”

Treasurer’s staff members are working nonstop throughout the day answering incoming calls to (405) 522-3333, the special number set up to take the calls. In addition, other staff members are returning calls and processing requests for reissued rebate checks.

“We will keep the lines open for as many days as it takes to hear from everyone with questions or problems,” Meacham said. “Please be patient with us. We’re working as fast as we can.”
