

EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, Oklahoma Governor J. Kevin Stitt issued Executive Order 2020-07 declaring an emergency in all 77 Oklahoma Counties caused by the impending threat of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, confirmed COVID-19 cases are increasing on a daily basis in the State of Oklahoma and this pandemic has the potential to cause considerable damage to public health; and

WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect public health, reduce further impact, ensure public safety and render emergency relief; and


WHEREAS, we, the Board of County Commissioners of Wagoner County, Oklahoma, do find that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the county, and create an emergency situation within the meaning of Section 683.3 of the Oklahoma Emergency Management Act of 2003, as amended;


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Board of County Commissioners of Wagoner County, Oklahoma, acting under the power vested in us by the State of Oklahoma do hereby declare Wagoner County to be in a state of emergency, entitle to aid, relief, and assistance and do hereby direct the implementation of the County Emergency Operations Plan.




