

Post Your 911 Number

The time you take to ensure that your address is clearly visible may save precious seconds when they are really needed!!

Permanent Posting of House Number

All residence and businesses should post their assigned 911 number to meet the following suggested guidelines:

- Numbers should be reflective and at least 6 inches in height.
- Numbers should be posted on the side of the house facing the driveway it is addressed from.
- Numbers should be easily read from the road and free from defect or obstruction.
- If the house is more than 150ft from the road it is addressed from, numbers should be clearly displayed on the mailbox, a reflective plate, or on a stake at the beginning of the driveway. Stakes should be 2-5 ft high, no more than 25ft from the driveway and easily visible from the road it is addressed from.
- If the numbers are posted on the mailbox, numbers should be located on both sides. The mailbox should be located within 25 ft of the driveway.
- If multiple houses are located on a driveway, they should have a stake at the beginning of the drive with all the house numbers posted on it, plus, there should be a stake or house number posted on each house on the drive.
- If you wish to purchase a 911 marker for your business or residence, you can call your local fire department or tag agency. Many fire departments are currently selling the reflective plate markers as a means of raising funds to improve fire protection. Many tag agencies offer the reflective plate for a small fee.

In an emergency, you cannot expect to be found if you tell a Communications Officer "Go to the old oak tree then go past the barn that burnt down five years ago". The Communications Officers have a GPS map and can see your location but the responders do not have the GPS map in their vehicles.
