


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I, August Thieleke, County Surveyor of Wagoner County, Oklahoma, hereby certify that I have surveyed the above tract, described as:

Know all Men by These Presents: That Albert R. Claxton and Loran Claxton of Coweta, Oklahoma, owners of the following described real estate in Wagoner County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point at the East side of Highway No. 51 and the South line of Lot 4 and the South line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 17 North, Range 16 East; thence East a distance of 646 feet; thence North at right angle a distance of 255 feet; thence West parallel with the South line of said Section a distance of 832 feet; thence a Southerly direction along the East line of Highway No. 51 a distance of 290 feet to the point of beginning, all in Wagoner County, Oklahoma,

have caused the same to be surveyed into blocks, lots and streets, in conformity to the annexed plat which he hereby adopts as the plat of the above described land under the name of "Albert Claxton Addition", and do hereby dedicate to public use, the streets, and avenues shown upon said plat.

That portion of land between Block 1 and Block 2, being a strip of land 40 feet in width, and 230.5 feet in length, as shown by said plat, shall be hereby designated and named "Floyd Street."

That strip of land lying between Block 2 and Block 3, being 40 feet in width, and 230.5 feet in length, as shown by said plat, shall be hereby designated and known and named "Loran Street."
