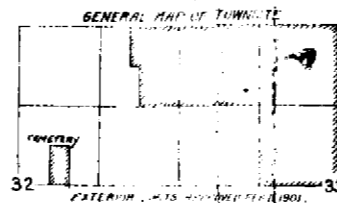
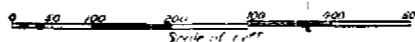


CLARKSVILLE, Creek Nation, I. T.

All distances are in feet and decimals thereof measured with a steel tape.
 Boundary limits are marked by stone monuments.
 All block and alley corners are marked by oak stakes 2" x 18".
 All block corners not marked hereon are right angles.
 Iron pins 1" diameter by 24" long have been sunk flush with surface of 6 base line intersections marked thus \odot .
 Where distances along exterior limits differ from those given by boundary surveys the distances given on this plat have been checked.
