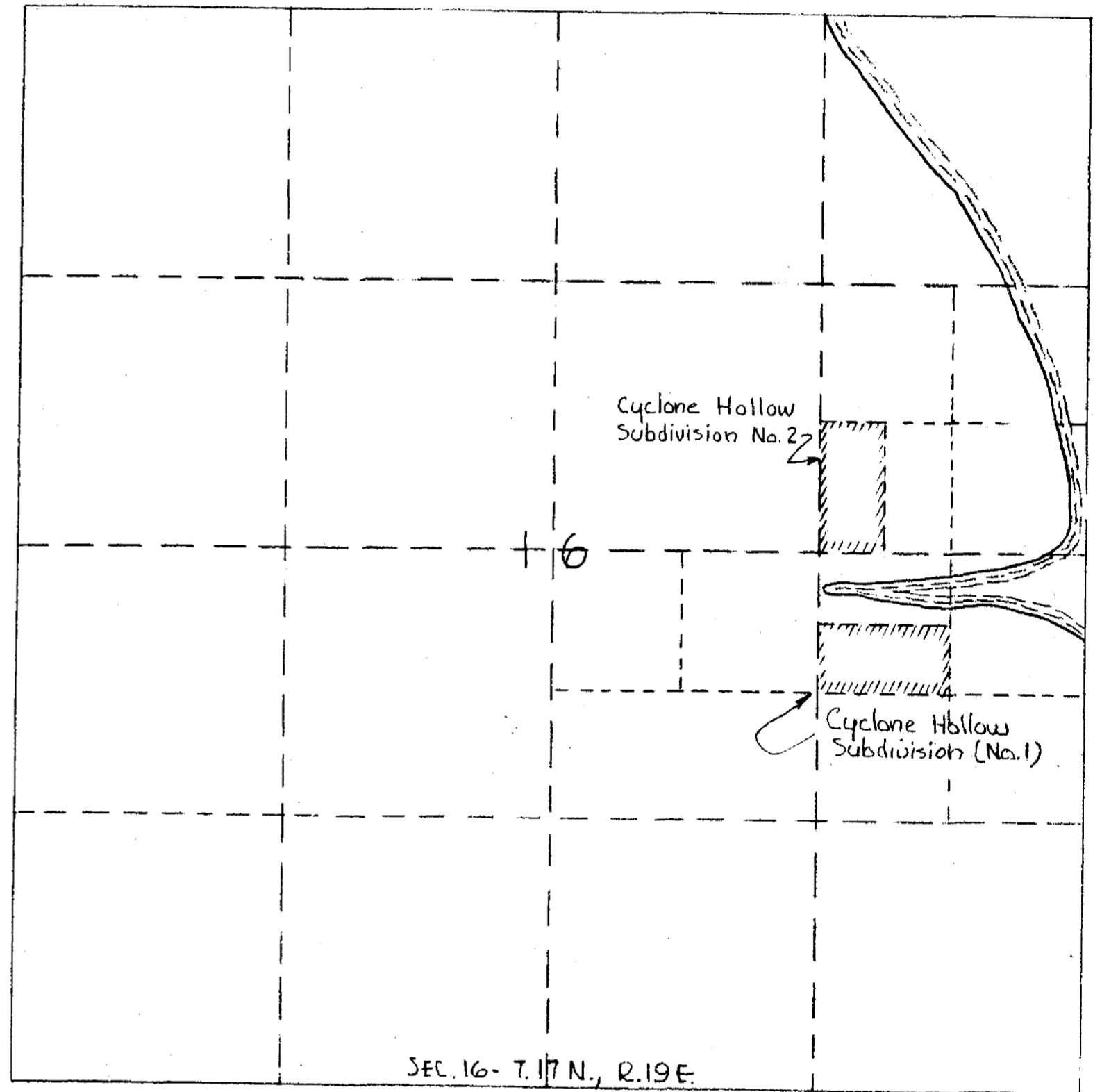
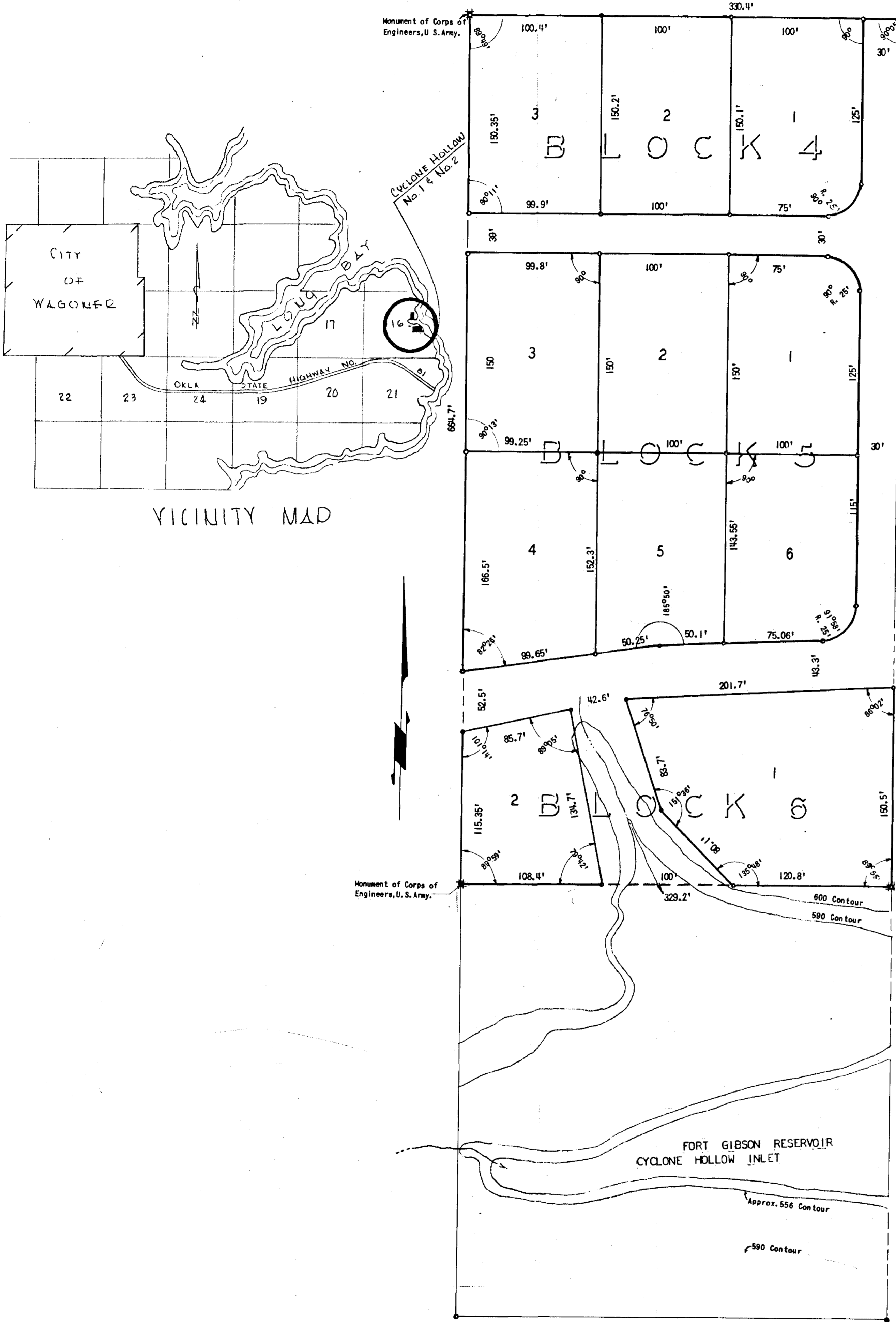


CYCLONE HOLLOW SUBDIVISION NO. 2
