


**Directions:** Southwest of the town of Red Bird. From Porter, turn left just before the railroad tracks. This road ends in a T with New Beginnings Residential Home on the left. Turn left, there are three or four houses then the road deadends. The cemetery is a little further out in the woods, southwest of the last house.

**History:** Named after Lulu Barber (F-4411) on whose land the burial grounds were located. Sometimes referred to as the Creek Indian Freedman Cemetery.

**Status:** Abandoned, densely wooded area, poison ivy, and blackberry bushes. Last surveyed in 2015.
