


Directions: Lat. 35.931066; Long. -95.644076: East of the intersection of South Avenue G and East Dogwood Place, Coweta, Oklahoma. (297th E Ave & 159th St So) There is a path into the cemetery from the street directly across from the house at 15966 S. 297th E. Ave. Take the path through the woods, across the bridge over the creek. The cemetery is on the hill among the trees. (After the bridge take the left fork of the path up the hill.)

History: Named after Emmett Bruner (C-5732), Creek Indian allottee. Formerly cemetery of the Coweta Mission School, which was founded in 1843 by Dr. Robert McGill Loughridge, a Presbyterian Missionary. The oldest marked grave in the county is located in Bruner cemetery. It is the tombstone of Mrs. Olivia (Hills) Loughridge (1816-1845), wife of Dr. Robert Loughridge. Full survey done 7/5/2013 by Rick & Sally Boyne.

Status: Inactive, now owned by the State of Oklahoma and preserved by Coweta chapter, Wagoner County Historical Society.
