

Childers Cemetery
S21, R17E, T18N, Coal Creek Township

Directions: From Highway 51, go North up Elevator Rd. (4220) approx. 5 miles to bridge over Bull Creek. The cemetery is about 1/2 mi west into the property in a grove of trees. (West of 4220 Rd, between 690 and 700 Rd.)

History: Located on Susan K. Childers (Roll-2792, Census 863) 160 acre Creek Indian allotment. Her father was Coweta Micco, her mother was Lydia Micco.

Status: Fenced. Some graves outside of fence, some unmarked. Very remote, not maintained. Private property. Another grave (Napoleon Bonaparte Childers) was found south of Childers cemetery on 700 Rd. across from old Rosebud School Dist 35. Also on private property. Last survey done in 2005.
