


Annie Kelley Cemetery  
S6, R15E, T17N, Shahan Township

**Directions:** East of 193rd E. Ave. (County Line Road) on north side of 131st Street in a grove of trees in a cultivated field. From the intersection of E 131st St S and S 193rd E Ave in Broken Arrow Go east on 131st about 1/2 mile, where paved road ends and gravel begins continue about 1/8 mile until the road narrows. There should be a double metal gate on the left. The cemetery is in the pasture past the gate about 1/8 of a mile to the north on private property. There is an abandoned cement block building beside the cemetery.

**History:** Named for Annie (Wiley) Kelley (C-602), who was a Creek Indian allottee, upon whose 160 tract this cemetery lies. Also known as the Chisholm-Perryman Cemetery.

**Status:** Family burial ground. Abandoned, not fenced or maintained.; Another survey states fenced in a grove of trees in a pasture. Some maintenance. Gate locked, on private property. Last surveyed in 2005.
