


**Directions:** On 41st Street, on and one-half miles east of County Line Road (193rd E Ave). (On 41st St east of 209th E Ave btwn Catoosa and Broken Arrow. There is a blue water tower, R.W.D. No. 4 south across the street. (Lat: 36 deg. 6' 17" N, Lon: 95 deg. 44' 05" W)

**History:** Named for Thomas Smith (F-4943), Creek Nation Freedman, donor of land. Mostly African Americans and a few White Americans buried here. Oldest grave - M. Jordan died 1902, most interesting - A.N. Pegues, a member of the last Creek Council, 1879-1959.

**Status:** Active, fenced. Not very well maintained. (Rows are read beginning on the East side, reading South to North.) Last surveyed May 16, 2014.
