Checks that **DO** qualify:

1. Was the check...passed within District 27? (Adair County – Cherokee County – Sequoyah County – Wagoner County)
2. Was the check...payment for merchandise, cash or services that were received when the check was passed?
3. Was the check...returned for Insufficient Funds (NSF), Account Closed or No Account Found from the bank?
4. Was the check...deposited within thirty days of the received date?

Checks that **DO NOT** qualify:

1. Payment on an account, post-dated, hold, or a two-party check
2. Have you accepted payment for the bogus check from the check writer?
3. Frozen/Blocked, Forgery, Signature Irregular, or Stop Payment on the check

**WHAT TO SEND TO OUR OFFICE?**

*(Please do not use staples or tape on the checks)*

**After submitting a check to our office for collection, payment CANNOT be accepted by the merchant. If the check writer contacts you to make a payment, please refer them to our office.**
