The end of the fiscal year is quickly approaching. Forms for your Estimate of Needs were distributed last week and our office is happy to provide balances, appropriations ledgers, salary increase work-sheets etc. in an effort to help you more accurately determine your needs for next year. Additionally, in an effort to make the process move more fluidly, here are some upcoming deadlines:

1. Because the last day of the fiscal year falls on a Sunday, the deadline for submitting P.O.'s for this fiscal year is 10:00am June 28, 2013 and must be for activities on or before June 28, 2013.
2. Blanket P.O.'s for July supplies must be submitted by Tuesday, June 25, 2013 and must be dated July 1, 2013. They will not be entered into the system until July 1, 2013.
3. Outstanding encumbrances for 2012-2013 fiscal year must be Invoiced by September 30, 2013.
4. I would like to have your Estimates of Needs for fiscal year 2013-2014 by June 7th. This will give me time to make a schedule for budget meetings with the Excise Board.
5. Temporary Appropriations will be made to ensure each office has operating monies until the budget is completed for FY 2013-2014.

Nickname.....

Oklahoma’s nickname is the “Sooner State.”

Oklahoma first opened to white settlers on April 22, 1889. At noon on that date, a starting gun signaled waiting settlers to enter Oklahoma to claim land. Land-hungry settlers who had sneaked into the area ahead of time-or “too soon”-were called “Sooners”.

- The traditional birthstone for June is the pearl. It is a symbol of purity and is the only gem that comes from living sea creatures.
- The flower for the month of June is the rose. Roses are a symbol of love and appreciation. They are also known as the flower of passion.

FATHER’S DAY is June 16th —established in early 20th century America. The holiday was considered casually by many people, but the main innovator was Sonora Dodd. Dodd held the first significant Father’s Day celebration in Spokane, Washington in 1910, held at the Spokane YMCA center. Dodd’s own father fought in the Civil War and then raised six children on his own in Spokane. When Dodd listened to a Mother’s Day sermon at her church, she considered the absence of her own mother, who had died in childbirth delivering her sixth child, and her Father’s valiant efforts of raising the children on his own, believing there deserved to be a holiday honoring fathers.
