I hereby certify that the location of the building in which low-point beer is to be sold is not prohibited by the provisions of 37 O.S. § 163.27, which requires a minimum distance of three hundred (300) feet from any public or private school or church property primarily and regularly used for worship services, unless certain exceptions apply.

the entity applying for this permit is a CORPORATION duly authorized to transact business in the State of Oklahoma,

each agent or employee managing or in charge of the place of business is at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and is maintaining and residing in a residence located in this county or _____ county, which is a county adjoining this county, and

the corporation applying for this permit agrees and consents that any and all notices required to be served under the provisions of 37 O.S. § 163.1, et seq., may be served on such resident agent(s) or employee(s).

Applicant hereby applies for a permit at the location described above to sell low-point beer, including any beverages containing more than one-half percent (1/2 of 1%) alcohol measured by volume, and not more than three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) alcohol measured by weight, for consumption or use in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma, including the provisions of 37 O.S. §§ 163.1 – 163.11. A special event permit issued pursuant to this application shall authorize the holder to sell and distribute low-point beer for a period not to exceed ten (10) consecutive days from the date of issuance. If this is an application for a new 3-year permit, or a special event permit, notice and a copy of the application must be mailed to the chief of police or marshal of the city or town, the sheriff, and the district attorney of the county in which the business or the special event is to be located. An applicant for a new 3-year permit must post notice of this application by the entrance on the front of the building in which the low-point beer is to be sold, and must file proof of such posting.

THIS APPLICATION IS A SWORN STATEMENT. I hereby swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, that I am a duly authorized agent or officer of the applicant corporation, and that I am empowered to sign this application and to bind the organization that I represent. I further swear or affirm that I have examined this application and any attachments, and all information furnished therein is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I acknowledge and understand that under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, Title 21, Section 491, a person who makes a false assertion in a sworn affidavit is guilty of perjury. I understand that willful omission or misrepresentation of any fact required to be disclosed on this application or any accompanying statement is grounds for denial or revocation of my low-point beer permit.
