I hereby certify that the location of the building in which low-point beer is to be sold is not prohibited by the provisions of 37 O.S. § 163.27, which requires a minimum distance of three hundred (300) feet from any public or private school or church property primarily and regularly used for worship services, unless certain exceptions apply.

Affidavit – Noncorporate Persons Complete this section: I hereby certify that

the individuals who hold a beneficial or ownership interest in the business are as follows (list names and addresses):

each applicant for this permit, and each individual who has a beneficial or ownership interest in the business is at least twenty-one (21) years of age,

each has maintained a bona fide residence in the State of Oklahoma for at least one (1) year prior to this application, and that each of these individuals is, at this time, actually residing in this county or in _____ county, which is a county adjoining this county.

Applicant hereby applies for a permit at the location described above to sell low-point beer, including any beverages containing more than one-half percent (1/2 of 1%) alcohol measured by volume, and not more than three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) alcohol measured by weight, for consumption or use in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma, including the provisions of 37 O.S. §§ 163.1 – 163.11. A special event permit issued pursuant to this application shall authorize the holder to sell and distribute low-point beer for a period not to exceed ten (10) consecutive days from the date of issuance. If this is an application for a new 3-year permit, or a special event permit, notice and a copy of the application must be mailed to the chief of police or marshal of the city or town, the sheriff, and the district attorney of the county in which the business or the special event is to be located. An applicant for a new 3-year permit must post notice of this application by the entrance on the front of the building in which the low-point beer is to be sold, and must file proof of such posting.

THIS APPLICATION IS A SWORN STATEMENT. I hereby swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, that I am duly authorized and empowered to sign this application and to bind the organization, if any, that I represent. I further swear or affirm that I have examined this application and any attachments, and all information furnished therein is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I acknowledge and understand that under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, Title 21, Section 491, a person who makes a false assertion in a sworn affidavit is guilty of perjury, and a person who falsely states that he or she is a United States citizen or a qualified alien may be subject to both federal and state criminal sanctions. I understand that willful omission or misrepresentation of any fact required to be disclosed on this application or any accompanying statement is grounds for denial or revocation of my low-point beer permit.
