1. Discussion and Possible Action on Proposed Amended Medical Fee Schedule.

The Commission has contracted with an external consultant to develop a report on the current Fee Schedule and a proposed amended Fee Schedule for the Commission's consideration. The Commission discussed the report and the proposed Fee Schedule and voted on releasing it for a thirty-day public comment period.

Commissioner Jordan Russell was recognized, reported on the process of developing the proposed fee schedule with the consultant, Fair Health, gave his recommendation, and responded to <u>questions of</u> the Commissioners' <u>questions</u>. Dr. Jay Cannon was also recognized to give a brief report and described a few highlights from the proposed fee schedule.

Motion: Commissioner Tilly moved to release the proposed amended fee schedule for a thirty-day public comment period.
