10. <u>Discussion and Possible Action regarding "Intent to Lease Office Space" agreement</u> for the new WCC Tulsa office

House Bill 4139 (2020) directed OMES to relocate state agencies currently housed within the Kerr Edmondson Building in Tulsa, Oklahoma, including the Workers' Compensation Commission, to a property owned by the Commissioners of the Land Office (CLO). The CLO and OMES have requested all agencies affected by this move sign a Letter of Intent to enter into a lease for space in the Executive Center upon its renovation. Chairman Liotta presented and answered questions of the Commission.

Lauren Hammonds Johnson was recognized, presented, and answered questions of the Commission.

Motion: Commissioner Russell moved that the Commission authorize the Chairman or the Chairman's designee to enter an "Intent to Lease Office Space" with the Commissioners of the Land Office with all terms to be determined at a later date.
